









QuickBooks Online Integration with WebJaguar

Configuration Step 1


Project Team run QuickBooks DB script from Mini

Configuration Step 2 – Initial Configuration



- 1. Log into the Admin of the site and click on SiteInfo
 - a. Click on the QuickBooks Configuration Tab
- 2. Set Quick Book Order Status:
 - This denotes what stage in the order process WJ will push orders into QuickBooks.
- 3. QuickBooks Start Orderld
 - a. This is the Orderld Number that will be the next to push (note you have to have an order in the system to figure out what to set this to).
- 4. Set QuickBooks PO Status

- a. This denotes what stage in the order process WJ will push Purchase Orders into QuickBooks.
- 5. QuickBooks Start PO Number
 - a. This is the PO Number that will be the next to push (note you have to have a PO in the system to figure out what to set this to).
- 6. Set the Limit per transaction
 - a. Options of 1, 3, 5, and 10
 - b. Suggestion start with 1 at first and adjust upwards as desired.
- 7. Shipping Default Account Type
 - a. Not required for QuickBooks Online.
- 8. QuickBooks Default Product Income Account (See Below Image)
 - a. This is the Account Name in QuickBooks that you use for tracking Sales Income
 - b. NOTE IT MUST BE EXACTLY AS IT APPEARS IN QuickBooks. Case Sensitive.




QuickBooks Default Product Income Account:	Product Income
QuickBooks Default Product Expense Account:	Cost of Goods Sold
QuickBooks Default Shipping Account:	Shipping Income
QuickBooks Customer Tax Code:	
Use Shipping Date as Invoice Date:	Replace Invoice Date with Ship Date for all the orders that are pushed to QuickBooks
Customer/Display Name Field ?:	Company \$
Track Inventory:	Creates items as inventory items and pushes only the OH value
Tax as order lineitem:	♥ Push Tax as a Order LineItem to QuickBooks


- 9. QuickBooks Default Product Expense Account
 - a. This is the Account Name in QuickBooks that you use for tracking Product Expenses (Commonly Cost of Goods Sold)
 - b. NOTE IT MUST BE EXACTLY AS IT APPEARS IN QuickBooks. Case Sensitive.
- 10. QuickBooks Shipping Account (*Not Required*)
 - a. This is the Account Name in QuickBooks that you use for Shipping Income (and will be used to pay your shipper ie UPS/FedEx)
 - b. NOTE IT MUST BE EXACTLY AS IT APPEARS IN QuickBooks. Case Sensitive.
- 11. QuickBooks Customer Tax Code
 - a. Self Explanatory Search in QuickBooks if you don't know this
- 12. Use Shipping Date as Invoice Date
 - a. Not Required. Self Explanatory.
- 13. Customer/Display Name Field
 - a. WJ allows mapping the Customer Name Field on QuickBooks to four different fields in WJ.

Configuration Step 3 – Sales Tax



Webjaguar's Tax rates and QuickBooks tax rates should match, if no match found payments might not be pushed to QuickBooks.


Configuration Step 4 - Item/Product Configuration




WJ product SKU should match with the QuickBooks Product Name, if no match is found, service would create a new product with "Default Account Type" Also when creating a new SKU/item in QuickBooks make sure to set an account type, WJ service requires an account type when adding the invoice to QuickBooks.

Configuration Step 5 - Payment Terms

Step 5: WebJaguar's payment terms should match with the QuickBooks payment terms or else the service will not add any orders in that transaction.



Step 5-1: For Credit Card payments, make sure to create a Payment Method called "credit card" on QuickBooks Online as shown below:



Connecting WebJaguar to QuickBooks Online

Once above configuration is completed, now we can connect WebJaguar to QuickBooks Online.


Step 1: Click on QuickBooks Tab and click on Connect to QBO button.




This will redirect the page to QuickBooks Login screen if you are not already logged into QuickBooks.

If you are already logged into QuickBooks then you can skip step 2 and go to step 3.


Step 2: Login into QuickBooks
